AN ORDINANCE ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING WAGES FOR PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Prevailing Wage Act which “. . . applies to the wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works . . . by any public body and to anyone under contracts for public work.” approved June 26, 1941, codified as amended, 820 ILCS 130/1 *et. seq.* (1933), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 48, par. 39s-1 *et seq.*, and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District (“District”), investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of DeKalb County, Illinois, employed in performing construction of public works for said District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District, DeKalb, Illinois:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by the Prevailing Wage Act approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the DeKalb County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 2017, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department’s June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the District. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the District to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The District shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the District this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.


SECTION 4: The District shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The District shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The District shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
