DeKalb Sanitary District

Hauled Wastewater Program

Before being allowed to discharge septage, porta potty waste, restaurant grease (FOG) or any other waste water to the DeKalb Sanitary District (District) your application must be approved by the District before any dumping is allowed.

A completed Wastewater Hauler Application must be submitted to the DeKalb Sanitary District for approval, along with current and valid copies of the following:

- 1) State of Illinois Department of Public Health Private Sewage Disposal System Pumping Contractor License – Not Applicable to porta pottys
- 2) DeKalb County Septage Pumper’s License – DeKalb County Septage Only
- 3) Certificates of Insurance for Company’s Comprehensive Automobile and General Liability insurance policies.
- 4) Vehicle registration of each vehicle that will be used to deliver hauled waste.
- 5) Illinois Driver’s License – for each driver who will be using the truck(s).
- 6) MSDS sheets for all chemical(s) used (Porta Pottys must supply)

If accepted, a letter allowing waste hauling to the District will be mailed to the business owner.

Dumping Procedure:

When dumping, the following procedures must be followed:

- 1) The largest septic truck tank size allowed to discharge shall not exceed 3,000 gallons unless otherwise approved.
- 2) Hauled waste receiving hours are Monday – Friday, 7:00 am – 3:00 pm, excluding holidays. Afterhours/weekend receiving can be accommodated for an additional charge.
- 3) Scheduling of domestic septage or porta potty waste receiving is not required. For FOG receiving, contact the District at (815) 758-3513 a minimum of 30 minutes prior to arrival.
- 4) At each dump, a sample bag (supplied by the District) must be filled and labeled with the Company Name, Date, Time and Driver’s Initials. The Waste Hauler Manifest must also be completed at that time. Random checks of the sampling procedure will be made and samples will be tested for conformity with domestic septage components.

Fees:

The District bills waste haulers on a monthly basis at the following rates:

Septage/Porta Potty	\$0.035 / gallon
FOG	\$0.05 / gallon
